Additionally, there will be countries making their first appearance in the event this year and, likewise, we are pleased to consider that the Bowling World Cup welcome new nations onto the international scene.

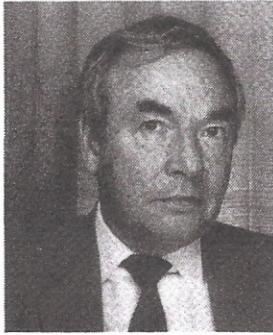

Format of Play

The 1986 tournament will comprise a series of eliminations over seven days.

Stage 1 – Qualifying Round

Men will roll 24 games and women 18 games of scratch total pinfall.

Stage 2 – Top 16

A round robin of on-game matches (bowled matchplay style) among the top sixteen players from Stage 1, starting from scratch, with special points system as follows:

1 point per pin
20 points per win
10 points each per tied match
5 points for a game between 200-249
10 points for a game between 250-300

Stage 3 – Semi Finals (Top 8)

A round robin of one-game matches (bowled matchplay style) among the top eight players from Stage 2, starting from scratch, utilising special points system mentioned above.

Stage 4 – Grand Finals (Top 5)

A one game step-ladder final in which No. 5 bowls No. 4. the winner bowls No. 3 that winner bowls No. 2 and then challenges the No. 1 for the title.

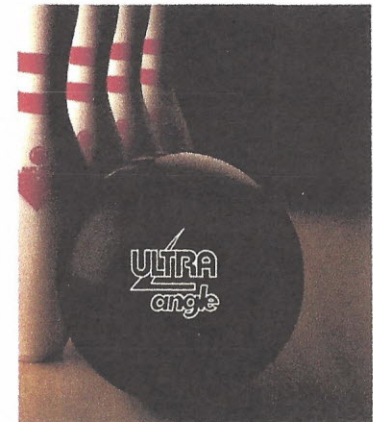

Danish Bowling – and World Cup

World Cup – We are all in it together. Cause, as the preliminary rounds are arranged in this country, the tournament has a message to each of us. Everyone have a chance, maybe not to win, but at least to get through the first step: the local final.

Then it gets a little more difficult. Because the winners of the local matches, meets in the so-called zonefinal, taking place in the western an eastern part of the country.

And to the festive and always exciting Denmarkfinal, in which the whole tournament is to be settle, are going 8 bowlers of each sex – and only one can win and make the travel. As a rule far from home – but, this is one of the fascinated things.

World record upon world record

One is speaking of world record in proportion to the number of participates when the yearly number of starts are added up. And we are proud of that in Denmark, where World Cup has so big traditions, and stand as one of the main events of the year.

World Cup is a integrated part of Danish bowling, the tournament has as headorganizer Danish Bowling Federation, but it is in the opening phases directed by the local unions.

World Cup is beginning allready in February, and have the Denmarkfinal in September. A long tournament, yes, but that makes it, in our opinion, just more attractive to participate in. For all bowlers – and now and then we can see a very suprisingly winner to the dreamfinal one or another place in the world.

Danish triumphs

It is an early Sunday morning, autum 1974. Breakfast has just arrived on the table – we are absentminded listen to the morningnews on the radio. Suddenly, something is happening: the speaker informs, that Birgitte Lund from Denmark has gone to the final i World Cup World Finals in Caracas, Venezuela. More information will come. Get hold of the cigarettes – will the very young dane succeed, and thereby create the untill now greatest sensation. What can that mean for the whole sport in Denmark? And at 9 o'clock the news came: Danish victory in Caracas. Birgitte had created the sensation and had conquered Dale Gray, Australien in the final.

Something happened in our country: at once a presscenter in Rødovre Bowlinghal was established, so all could have the chance to here more about the breaking of bowlingsport. Radio, TV and the writing press were overflowing and when Birgitte Lund and Jan Donde, who placed himself on a fine 8. place, went home, a very great ovation was waiting. Not a everyday occurrence for a Danish sport-sactive on this time.

The importance for Danish bowling has kept on, well supported of a long numbers of international placements in the following years.

Even to day there are sent for Birgitte Lund, now named Jensen, when bowling is calling in greater connexions.

Jakarta

Dansk Bowling – og World Cup

WORLD CUP – Vi er med alle sammen. For som turneringens indledende faser er tilrettelagt her i landet, har den bud til os alle. Alle har chancen, om ikke, af gode grunde, for at vinde, så da i det mindste for at komme gennem det første nåleøje: den lokale semifinal.

Så bliver det straks lidt sværere. For de bedste fra de lokale opgør, mødes i zonefinalen, henholdsvis i den vestlige og østlige del af Danmark.

Og tilbage til den festlige og altid spændende Danmarkfinal, hvor det hele afgøres, bliver kun 8 bowlere af hvert køn – og kun en skal videre. Ofte langt fra hjemmet – men det er netop det, der er det facinerende.

Verdensrekord på verdensrekord

Der tales om verdensrekord set i forhold til medlemstallet, når det årlige, samlede startantal gøres op. Og det er vi da stolte af her i landet, hvor World Cup har så store traditioner, og indgår som en del af hovedbegivenhederne set over et år. World Cup er en integreret del af dansk bowling, turneringen har som hovedarrangør Dansk Bowling forbund, men dirigeres i de indledende faser af de lokale kredse og unioner.

World Cup startes op allerede i februar måned, og finder først sin afslutning i september. En lang turnering, men det mener vi gør den endnu mere attraktiv at være med i. For alle bowlere – og vi ser da også ind imellem meget overraskende vindere til drømmefinalen et eller andet sted på jordkloden.

Danske triumfer

Det er en tidlig søndag morgen efteråret 1974. Morgenmaden er just kommet på bordet – vi lytter adspredt til morgennyhederne i radioavisen. Pludselig kommer der liv i kludene. Speakeren meddeler, at Birgitte Lund er kommet i finalen ved World Cup verdensfinalen i Caracas. Og at nærmere følger. Frem med cigaretterne – skal det virkelig lykkes den unge dansker at skabe den hidtil største sensation, og hvad vil det ikke komme til at betyde for dansk bowling. Man blev helt mat i knæene. Og kl. 9.00 kom nyheden: dansk sejr i World Cup, Caracas. Birgitte havde skabt sensationen og besejret Dale Gray, Australien i finalen.

Så kom der gang i sagerne her til lands. Med øjeblikkelig indsats fra alle fronter. I Rødovre Bowlinghal blev der oprettet et pressecenter, så alle kunne komme til at høre mere om bowlingsportens gennembrud her til lands. Radio, TV og dagspressen strømmede over og ved hjemkomsten ventede der Birgitte Lund og Jan Donde, som placerede sig på en flot 8. plads, en hyldest, som man sjældent ser en dansk idrætsudøver er til del – i hvert fald på den tid..

Betydningen for dansk bowling i almindelighed har holdt sig, godt understøttet af en lang række internationale placeringer i de år, som fulgte. Den dag i dag er der bud efter Birgitte Lund, som nu heder Jensen, når bowling kalder i større sammenhænge.

Djarkarta

Det er torsdag i World Cup ugen 1980. Verdensfinalen spilles i Djarkarta, Indonesien, og vi har Johnny Christiansen fra Stenhuset og Kirsten Christiansen, Chock på plads. Telefonen ringer. Det er Politiken: »Er der noget om, at I har en bowlingspiller i Djarkarta?« »Ja« – »Han fører hele herligheden«.

Johnny lead the World Final at a time, where there where 16 players back. And he was standed by! And continued: was between the last 4 and ended up as a fine number 3 in a very hard tournament. Again flowers to Danish bowling with relation to World Cup.

Bogota

Birgitte Lund almost did it again. She had in 1978 placed herself to the World Final, taking place in the paradise of pickpockets, Bogota, Colombia. She succeeded getting between the 4 best, and the whole country kept it's breath this very late Friday evening in 1978. But she stood by as number 4, enough to that we again got spotlights on our sport. Yes, the public is very interested in World Cup, and with excitement we, year after year, have followed the Danish bowlers fight to the pins. It has been close several times – we havent got numbers on the many placements as number 9, especially our ladies have got.

Disappointments? – Yes, but they are all forgotten!

The future

As long as something is named World Cup, Danish bowling is on the map! This year on the homealleys in Rødovre Bowlinghal. To the danish bowlers not a great travel, but as Anne Rath said, when she went home from Seoul in 1985: »It is not so much the place of playing, which is most attractive by World Cup. It is the mood and the atmosphere in the week, the tournament is going. You have to experience it, no-matter, where it takes place.«
World Cup is a world for itself.

Og så har der da også været skuffelser, det har vi ikke taget med, for hvad betyder de nu?

Fremtiden

Så længe der er noget, der hedder World Cup, er dansk bowling med. I år i hjemmehallen Rødovre Bowlinghal. Derved ikke den store rejse for den danske spiller, men som Anne Rath sagde ved hjemkomsten fra Seoul i 1985: »Det er egentlig ikke spillestedet, som er det mest attraktive ved World Cup. Det er stemningen og atmosfæren i den uge, kampene afvikles. Den skal opleves, og så er det lige meget, hvor der spilles.«

Last Year's Winners

Ireland's Marjorie McEntee and Mexican Alfonso Rodriguez were the champions of their respective divisions in the Bowling World Cup staged in Seoul, Republic of Korea last year.

Marjorie emulated Britain's Pauline Smith by winning her title the hard way. She went into the step-ladder finals in 5th position and worked her way through Pearly Chong (Malaysia), Yuen-Yue Huang (Chinese Taipei), Annete Hagre (Sweden) and Judy Howlett (Gt. Britain) before emerging triumphant.

Alfonso became Mexico's second title-holder in the tournament's 21-year history by finishing in the coveted No1 spot when it mattered – the stage before the step-ladder finals. When Dutchman Eric Kok challenged him for the title, Rodriguez did just enough to run out the winner by 206 to 193.

World Cup – et æventyr

Efter at have overværet 16 af de indtil nu 22 afholdte World Cup finaler, kan man konstatere, at turneringen er bowlingårets største begivenhed. Den atmosfære, der hersker i den hektiske World Cup uge, kan ikke sammenlignes med noget andet i idrætsverdenen.

World Cup er den begivenhed, hvor venskabsbånd knyttes fastere mellem deltagere, ledere og journalister - mere end ved nogen begivenhed i idrætten. Det kan jeg fastslå, efter nær ved 35 års arbejde som sportsjournalist. Og når man graver i mindearkivet, er der mange detaljer, som er gemt her. Ikke bare præstationerne på selve banerne. World Cup har fundet sted i samtlige verdensdele, og mange eksotiske lande har jeg kunnet stifte bekendtskab med. Mange kulturer er det blevet muligt for mig at få indblik i. Mange minder er forbundne med de restaurationsbesøg, hvor hidtil ukendte madretter er blevet testet - i nogle tilfælde med stort besvær.

STARTEN

World Cup fik en flyvende start, da AMF for første gang indbød til "International Masters Championships" i det den gang helt ukendte Irland. Ukendt indenfor bowlingsporten, men det blev et minderigt arrangement i Dublin. For nordisk bowling med en glædelig hændelse, da Finlands Lauri Ajanto sejrede.

Efter Dublin var det tid for London. Vic Kalmans ide begyndte at tage form. Bowlingen havde fået sin verdensomspændende storturnering.

Efter London var det Paris, som stod for tur til at påtage sig arrangementet. Nu vidste man definitivt, at turneringen ville overleve.

1968 var det tid for Mexico, som det første ikke europæiske land, at arrangere. Spillestedet: eksotiske Guadalajara. Aret efter fik turneringen for første gang navnet AMF World Cup, og vinduet til Asien blev åbnet for første gang. Tokyo stod inde for værtskabet, medens Vic Kalman for sidste gang stod for arrangementet.

PREMIERE I RØDOVRE

Rødovrehallen skulle skabe rammen om 1970 årets World Cup. En uforglemmelig oplevelse for dansk bowling. Et perfekt arrangement med 40 nationer på plads for første gang.

Sejren gik til vesttysklands Klaus Müller, som besejrede Henry Tan fra Singapore i finalen. Men hvad de fleste nok husker mest fra Rødovre, foruden selve kampene, var nok, at det var koldt i København - meget koldt. De orientalske gæster ville helst opholde sig indendørs!

Men i 1971 kom man ind i varmen igen. Her stod Hong Kong for invitationen. Nu var det Paul Lane, som holdt trådene i en

turnering, som mere og mere blev betragtet som bowlingsportens mest fremtrædende. Stadig kun med herrerne i focus, men nu skulle det være. 1972 i Hamburg var det tid for at tage damerne med. Det var den mexicanske veteran Irma Urrea, som skrev bowlinghistorie ved at vinde den første kvindelige World Cup. På herresiden fik vi for første gang fornøjelsen af, at stifte bekendtskab med Canadas Ray Mitchell, nuværende holdleder for Canadas landshold, som vandt suverænt.

1973 var det igen Asiens tur. Singapore med legendariske Jackie's Bowl, stod for et uforglemmeligt arrangement.

DANNEBROG TIL TOPS

1974 står i al fremtid skrevet med guldbogstaver i dansk bowlings historie. Caracas var spillestedet, og øverst på sejrskamlen stod Rødovres Birgitte Lund. På herresiden stod Jan Donde, nu halchef i Rødovre, for en anden strålende indsats ved at placere sig som ottendende mand i det stærke finalfelt. Dansk bowling kom på een gang i rampelyset, en placering, som man siden den gang med held har forsvaret ved utallige bowlingarrangementer.

Manila på Philippinerne blev næste stoppested for World Cup, som nu mere og mere

støttede sig til de asiatiske lande. Blandt højdepunkterne i den turnering var et besøg i præsidentpaladset, hvor præsident Marcos tog imod alle deltagerne.

1976 kom Iran med i bowlingsammenhæng for alvor. Teheran indbød til årets bowlinghøjdepunkt. For første gang fik Verden lejlighed til at stifte bekendtskab med den unge Paeng Nepomuceno fra Philippinerne, som helt dominerede turneringen. Den 17-årige gut tog sin første store sejr.

1977 var det igen London's tur, og den engelske hovedstad fik nu for anden gang til opgave at stå for World Cup. Her skrev Arne Svein Strøm fra Norge bowlinghistorie, ved i en spændende finale, at besejre favoritten Philippe Dubois, Frankrig.

1978 var det Sydamerikas tur igen. Nu i Colombias hovedstad Bogota. Og igen med Birgitte Lund i en af de mere fremtrædende roller. Sejren gik dog til Philippinerne Lita de la Rosa, som iøvrigt vandt VM titlen året efter.

FANTASTISKE BONG COO

1979 var det Bangkok med Sukhumvit Bowl som skabte rammen for World Cup. Hvad man mindes mest er Bong Coos formidable opvisning i damefinalen. Den unge kvinde fra Philippinerne havde et formidabelt strikslag og spillede damebowling, som Verden aldrig tidligere havde set magen til. Herrefinalen blev vundet af Frankrigs Philippe Dubois efter sin andenplads to år i træk. Asien blev det igen året efter. Nu i Indonesien, en turnering, hvor de fleste af spillerne blev ramt af en mavesygdom. Helt uberørt var dog fantastiske Paeng Nepomuceno, som nu tog sin anden sejr i den globale storturnering.

USA havde længe stået på bowlernes ønskeliste. 1981 var det så langt om længe tid for at gæste det store bowlingland i vest. Legendariske Madison Square Garden i New York, indbød til en fantastisk bowlingfest.

1982 var vi "hjemme" i Europa igen. Nu i hollandske Scheveningen, hvor Norges Arne Svein Strøm spillede med hele sit fantastiske bowlingregister. Den fænomenale nordmand tog sin og Norges anden sejr, medens det for Sverige længe så lyst ud med hensyn til endelig at kunne triumfere i World Cup. Inger Levhorn lå i toppen af turneringen hele vejen igennem, men blev i finalen passeret af Jeanette Baker, Australien.

Baker tog sejren hjem igen året efter, da World Cup for anden gang gæstede Mexico. Nu i selve hovedstaden Mexico City. Året efter kom den virkelige lange rejse for de fleste. Australien, et af de mest fremgangsrige bowlinglande i Verden, indbød til Sydney.

Et fantastisk arrangement med Alison Driscoll og Steve Mackie som de drivende kræfter bag succes.

1985 havde Sydkorea ansvaret for værtskabet. Et meget koldt Seoul var rammen om turneringen, som blev vundet af den vældige Alfonso Rodrigues fra Mexico og den store overraskelse, Irlands Marjorie Mc Entee. På den afsluttende banket kunne den daværende forbundsformand Frank Rasmussen meddele, at Rødovre havde fået overdraget arrangementet i 1986.

PROFILER MAN MINDES

Jeg har lært et tusindtal personer at kende ved World Cup arrangementerne. Venskabsbånd er knyttet - mange for livet. AMF, som står for arrangementet og har gjort det siden starten, hvor mange store bowlingpersonligheder indblandet. Navne som Vic Kalman, Paul Lane, Alison Driscoll, Steve Mackie, Svend Erik Skoglund, Woody Woodruff, Bent Petersen, Jack Graziano og Mike Fiorentino har alle på deres måde bidraget til at skabe årets populæreste bowlingturnering i hele Verden.

FIQ ledere som Kauko Ahlstrøm, Frank Baker, Maurice Glazer, Robert Tan, Dr. P. S. Nathan, Roger Tessmann og Eero Routamo har alle bidraget til, at netop World

Cup har fået den opbakning, som turneringen fortjener.

Sidst, men ikke mindst, mine skrivende kolleger. Mort Luby, USA, som ikke har mistet nogen World Cup siden starten. En utrolig inspirationskilde for alle os andre. Barry James, England, som ligesom Mort har været med ved samtlige World Cup finaler for telegrambureauet Reuters regning. Bernhard Mora, Paris, som har rapporteret til den fransktalende del af Verden de seneste 15 år. Keith Hale, England, som sjældent savnes i et World Cup presserum. Frank Sisson, Canada, Ad Ophelders, Holland, Steve James, USA, Steve Mackie, Australien, Shig Fujita, Japan, John Jørgensen, Danmark, Dieter Schön, Vesttyskland, Ray Mitchell, Canada, Henry Winey, Canada, Tudor Wijayasinha, Thailand plus en lang række af journalister fra Verdens kroge, har gjort World Cup til et uforglemmeligt minde for mig - ikke mindst via timelange debatter og diskussioner om bowlingens og World Cup's fremtid.

Timerne i det hektiske presserum, fremstår altid som store øjeblikke, når man bag efter ser tilbage.

At nævne spillere, som man gennem alle årene er kommet i kontakt med, er meget svært. Men helt sikker er dog visse spillere, som specielt har efterladt et varigt indtryk. Paeng Nepomuceno, Bong Coo og Lita de la Rosa fra Philippinerne. Arne Svein Strøm, Norge, Birgitte Lund, Danmark, Ray Mitchell og Jean Gordon, Canada, Carlos Lovera, Venezuela, Kurt Lundquist, Göran Grape og Inger Levhorn, Sverige, Chris Batson, Ruth Guerster og Jeanette Baker, Australien, Lauri Ajanto, Finland, Philippe Dubois, Frankrig, Lois Mambelli og Daniela Lana, Italien samt i hundredevis af spillere fra alle verdenshjørner. Alle personligheder på og udenfor banerne.

MAVEN HAR FÅET SIT

Højtidsstunder har der ligeledes været, når man tænker på fritiden mellem kampene. Hvor mange mystiske madretter jeg, sammen med min bedste ven Mort Luby, har testet Verden over, ved jeg ikke, men det er mange! Uforglemmelige stunder med fjerne Østens delikatesser, hummer i kromosonformat, krydret mad, som ville tage rusten bort fra min bil. Utroligt, at maven har klaret disse overraskelser.

Kulturen, som vi har snuset til. Frem for alt de manifikke templer i Asien. De lange busture i eksotiske lande. Afslapningen på fantastiske Bali efter finalen i Djarkarta i 1980. Tempeldanserne i Thailand, Mariachimusikken i Mexico. Lommetyvene i Colombia og New York. De lange flyvetimer. Alt sammen uforglemmelige minder, som man ikke kunne være foruden.

Men det bedste af alt: æventyret fortsætter. Nu i Rødovrehallen. Måske ikke så fantastisk, når man kan se hallen fra køkkenvinduet hjemme, men for mange af deltagerne en ny fantastisk oplevelse. At komme fra den sydlige halvkugle, fra det fjerne Østen til Danmark, er for dem den samme oplevelse, som det er for mig at gæste deres fjerne lande.

Nye venskabsbånd vil blive knyttet over alle grænser. For alle vil årets World Cup blive bevaret i mindernes arkiv, som en af de store begivenheder i deres liv. Det er præcis det World Cup er i første række.

Det er ikke kun en turnering - det er et æventyr.
